

Mesa Associates Opens New Greeneville Facility

Mesa Associates, Inc., on Tuesday celebrated the company's 20th anniversary and the opening of its newly located Greeneville Technical Services and Fabrication facility.

The event was held at the plant, located at 55 Marley Drive in Greeneville.

Mesa officers, along with the Greene County Partnership, held a ribbon-cutting ceremony, open house and luncheon for 150 guests.

The occasion included customers, manufacturers, vendors and Mesa employees from the Greeneville, Knoxville and Kingsport offices.

Rodney Huffman, the company's business unit manager, cut the ribbon held by Tim Ramsey, a Mesa associate vice president, and Gary Guyette, another associate vice president. They were joined by Tim Cutshaw, vice president of Mesa's Industrial Division, and by other Mesa employees.

Mesa Associates Inc. has provided engineering and design services to industrial and utility clients since 1988.

The company has nearly 400 employees located in five offices in Tennessee and one office in Alabama.

Mesa started the Panel Fabrication group in 2003 as a value-added service to the projects engineered and designed by Mesa.

The original shop was located in Kingsport, where the business plan was proven and a client base established.

In 2005, panel fabrication became a distinct business unit, and was moved to a larger location in Mosheim. This unit is now referred to as the "Technical Services and Panel Fabrication Business Unit."

Due to growth, this operation was moved last month to a 12,000-square-foot facility in Greeneville.

The Greeneville unit supplies build-to-print panels to several original equipment manufacturers (OEM)s, but also specializes in custom engineered UL-listed panels with stamped, certified drawing sets.
